



# *Rules and Regulations*

## EASTCHESTER TOWN BOARD

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## LAKE ISLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

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# **I. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS**

## **A. COMPLIANCE IS MANDATORY**

All users of Lake Isle facilities are required to comply with rules and regulations as published herein and those posted about the premises.

## **B. IDENTIFICATION and AUTHORIZATION REQUIRED**

1. Only those persons with valid Lake Isle issued membership cards or having obtained other valid authorization may utilize Lake Isle facilities.
2. Lake Isle staff have full authority to require the display of membership cards, receipts and/or other personal identification prior to or during use of the facilities. Verification of age and place of residence may be required.
3. Lending of a Lake Isle membership card is strictly prohibited and will result in suspension of privileges.

## **C. POLICY, PROCEDURE AND SCHEDULE CHANGES**

1. All policies, procedures, schedules and fees for the use of Lake Isle facilities are subject to change at any time and all users must comply.
2. The Lake Isle Managers have administrative authority over day-to-day operations and users of Lake Isle facilities, as well as the right to alter and adjust fees, playing and operating schedules and to close facilities for reasons including but not limited to special events, reasons of safety and public welfare and that no refunds or credits of any fees will be granted for any reason.
3. Scheduled closures and restriction on use of Lake Isle facilities will be posted in advance when possible. When weather is in question, call (914) 961-3453. The lightning detection system will sound a high-pitched horn to alert patrons using the facility that a storm is imminent. A 15-second blast means everyone must evacuate the immediate areas, as directed by staff. Three 5-second blasts mean that it is safe to return, as directed by staff.
4. Services and access may be limited due to operational difficulties and unforeseen circumstances.
5. Lake Isle reserves the right to limit enrollment of new and renewing Non-Resident memberships at any time.
6. Lake Isle reserves the right to take pictures and/or videos to post on all promotional mediums.
7. Soliciting, loitering, promoting or posting on bulletin boards is prohibited.

## **D. CHILDREN**

Children under age 14 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (age 18 and over) while anywhere on the premises. See Golf, Pool Complex and Tennis Rules and Regulations for specifics and exceptions regarding children.

## **E. FOOD AND BEVERAGES**

Food and beverages may only be consumed in designated eating areas or the Snack Bar. See Section III - Pool Complex Rules & Regulations, Paragraph F

## **F. LITTER**

All garbage and recyclables must be deposited in the appropriate receptacles. Disposable diapers must be wrapped in a plastic bag before being put in receptacles.

## **G. REFUNDS AND CREDITS**

There will be no refunds of any admission related or rental (golf carts, etc.) fees paid. No credits for inclement weather ("rainchecks") will be granted on any admission related fees paid.

## **H. PETS**

Dogs, cats or any other pets may not be brought onto Lake Isle premises with the exception of service dogs.

## **I. LOCKER ROOMS**

1. Only those renting lockers are permitted to use the locker room facilities.
2. Lake Isle towels may not be removed from locker rooms.
3. Children under the age of 14 will not be permitted in the locker rooms unless accompanied by an adult (age 18 and over). Children age 4 and over of the opposite sex cannot be brought into the locker rooms, restrooms or changing facilities. Family restrooms are available by the Snack Bar outside the pool complex.
4. Lockers must be vacated as requested by the date(s) posted. Keys must be returned at the end of the season.

## **J. RESPONSIBILITY FOR BELONGINGS**

1. The Town of Eastchester will not be held responsible for any personal property brought onto Lake Isle premises including but not limited to any items stored in the Lake Isle locker rooms.
2. Lake Isle reserves the right to search coolers, bags, backpacks and other items at any time.
3. All items lost by those engaged in golf-related activities will be secured in the Golf Pro Shop.
4. All other lost items:
  - Valuables will be secured in the main office.
  - Non-valuables may be disposed of or donated within 24 hours.

## **K. GAMBLING**

Gambling is prohibited on Lake Isle premises.

## **L. COURTESY**

1. Shirts must always be worn with the exception of the locker rooms and pool complex.
2. Users of Lake Isle facilities must at all times be courteous to others and staff.
3. All Lake Isle users must refrain from loud and/or boisterous actions that interfere with the enjoyment of facilities by other Lake Isle users. Use of abusive/offensive language or conduct will not be tolerated and may result in suspension of privileges.
4. Radios and any other audio/video devices must be equipped and operated with earphones.
5. Cell phones, cameras or any device with a camera on it may not be used in the locker rooms, bathrooms or changing areas.

## **M. SUSPENSION OF PRIVILEGES**

1. Any person observed violating any Lake Isle rule or regulation is subject to immediate suspension of any and all privileges by Management or any Lake Isle staff member authorized to do so by Management.
2. Management may review the violation and/or suspension with the Lake Isle Advisory Committee, or a subcommittee thereof. The alleged violator may be required to appear in person to discuss his/her actions. Failure to appear upon request at the time and place set forth by written notice may result in further penalty.
3. Any person damaging or defacing any Lake Isle/Town of Eastchester real or personal property will be subject to suspension of all Lake Isle privileges in addition to possible legal action.

## **N. DAILY FEE USE**

1. Use of Lake Isle facilities is available on a user fee basis. Individual rates apply per round of golf, per pool complex admission and/or per hour of tennis court use.
2. Rates and schedules of fee use are posted throughout the facility and online.
3. Fee users must pay prior to use of facilities.
4. Fee use is not available when facilities are closed.
5. Non-Resident daily fee users must be accompanied by a Lake Isle member or a Resident daily fee user.

6. Resident daily fee users must provide a valid ID (i.e., driver's license) to prove residency.
7. Daily fee use by the same individual permitted only up to 6 times in a season.
8. Restrictions in this section may vary for tennis fee use. Refer to Section IV - Tennis Rules and Regulations, Paragraph G.

## **II. GOLF RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **A. GENERAL**

1. All players must cooperate fully with the rules and regulations enforcement efforts of the Golf Pro, Golf Starter(s), and Golf Course Ranger(s). All General Rules and Regulations (Section I) apply in addition to Golf Rules and Regulations.
2. United States Golf Association (U.S.G.A.) rules govern all golf play unless special local rules apply. Special local rules are posted in the golf starting area. All players are required to comply with these rules including those pertaining to proper golf etiquette.
3. All players must register as instructed in the golf starting area (or Golf Pro Shop) at least 20 minutes before commencing play.
4. The Greens Superintendent or designee thereof has authority to order closure or restriction on use of the golf course and/or golf carts as a result of weather conditions or construction efforts. Golf course restrictions and special event closures are posted on the golf area bulletin boards. Golfers must honor any such closure or restriction.
5. Only those involved in golf play and those performing authorized work functions are permitted on the golf course. Spectators are only permitted on the golf course for special tournaments as designated by the Golf Pro.
6. Extreme caution must be observed when playing. Defer play when other players or staff members are within range and in danger.
7. All Lake Isle patrons, including guests and visitors, assume all risk and danger incidental to the game of golf whether on the golf course or in any other area of the facility including but not limited to the pool complex and tennis courts including specifically (but not exclusively) the danger of being injured by hit golf balls, swung golf clubs and agree that the facility, its players, management and staff, and the Town of Eastchester are not liable for injury related from such causes.
8. Each player may only play one ball at a time unless obtaining golf instruction. Practicing is not permitted on the golf course except under the guidance of the Golf Pro. The golf driving range may be used for a nominal fee when in operation.
9. No more than four players may play in one group at any time except during the months of November through March when "fivesomes" and "sixsomes" may be permitted upon authorization from the Golf Pro.
10. Players must play holes in proper sequence. Players are forbidden to "cut in" from one hole to another out of rotation.
11. Players may only begin play on the tenth tee when authorized by the Golf Pro or Golf Starter.
12. Players may not enter private property adjoining the golf course to retrieve any golf ball driven out of bounds.
13. Golf clubs and bags may only be stored at the Golf Pro Shop upon payment of storage fees. All stored and/or repaired clubs and bags must be removed no later than December 15th.

### **B. REQUIRED CARE OF THE GOLF COURSE**

1. All players must exercise care of the golf course by replacing their divots and repairing their ball marks on the greens. Players must enter and exit sand traps at lowest point and smooth sand after shot.
2. Players must obey "ground under repair" signs. Drop your ball one club length, no nearer to the hole, from nearest point of relief.

### **C. PACE OF PLAY**

1. Players must avoid delay in play and cooperate with Golf Ranger “speed up” efforts. Consideration of other players will make play more enjoyable for all.
2. Players not ready to play at their designated time will be “dropped back” to a later time at the discretion of the Golf Starter(s).
3. Greens must be vacated immediately on completion of hole.
4. Slower players with a hole open ahead and those players searching for a lost ball for more than five minutes must signal the following group to play through. If not signaled, this group may request permission to play through.
5. Prime time play will be monitored by official time clocks. Those players not meeting the time requirement for pace-of-play may be asked to leave and issued a refund of any golf cart charges for that day.

### **D. GOLF CARTS**

1. No power or hand golf carts are permitted on tees, slopes of tees, greens, aprons of greens or in sand traps. Power golf carts must be parked on cart paths and/or cart parking areas where available when play is near tees and greens.
2. No more than two persons properly seated and two golf bags are permitted per power cart at any time. Pulling of hand carts by power cart users is prohibited and will result in golf privilege suspension.
3. All players must drive carts carefully. Reckless driving and abuse of carts will result in suspension of privileges. Cart users must obey all cart signs and power carts must be driven on cart paths where available.
4. Power and hand carts are available for rental during Golf Pro Shop hours. A power cart rental is mandatory for all scheduled tee times prior to 10am on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays (as celebrated by Lake Isle). For 10am-3pm on Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays (as celebrated by Lake Isle) and opening until 3pm on weekdays, a power or hand cart rental is required (a personal hand cart can be used but a hand cart fee still applies). After 3pm (all days), rental of a cart is optional as players may walk their bags (a personal hand cart can be used at no fee) during that time.
5. General driving of power carts on fairways is prohibited, 90° Rule applies (if unfamiliar with this rule see golf staff).
6. No personal power golf carts are permitted at any time.
7. Personal hand golf carts are only permitted when Lake Isle owned rental hand carts are not available and/or authorization has been obtained from the Golf Pro (a fee for a hand golf cart may apply).
8. Golf carts will not be issued until 15 minutes prior to starting time.
9. Power golf carts will only be issued to those age 17 and older unless in possession of a valid driver’s license.
10. Power and hand carts must be returned to the cart drop off area immediately upon completion of round, but no later than posted return times.

### **E. CHILDREN (PRIORITY OF PLAY)**

1. Children, age 12 to 17 are permitted to play golf after 11:30am on weekdays and after 1:30pm on weekends and holidays.
2. Children under age 14 may not play golf without the approval of the Golf Pro. Such approval is based upon the young person’s knowledge of golf etiquette and general maturity.
3. Children, age 9 through 11 may not play until 4pm and must be accompanied by an adult (age 18 and over) player.
4. Children, age 9 and older, may also play golf on Mondays after 1pm without adult accompaniment if approval (as per E2 above) has been obtained from the Golf Pro and provided that there are no other special scheduled golf activities for the day.
5. Children under age 9 are not permitted on the golf course.

## **F. DRESS CODE**

1. No metal spikes permitted.
2. Players are permitted to play in walking shorts. Shirts with collars must be worn. Playing in bathing, cycling or gym-type shorts, cut-off jeans or slacks, halters, strapless or tank-type shirts is prohibited. All jeans are prohibited.

## **G. RESERVATION SYSTEM—FRIDAYS, WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS**

1. Golf starting time reservations are accepted for all seven days, including holidays during April through October or as deemed appropriate by the Golf Pro.
2. Prime Starting Time is hereby defined as those golf starting times prior to 11:30am on Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays (as celebrated by Lake Isle).
3. Only adults (age 18 and over) included on Lake Isle seasonal memberships with full week golfing privileges may reserve time for play during Prime Starting Time hours.
4. For weekday reservations (Monday-Friday, excluding holidays), a reservation can be made one week in advance in person with the Golf Starter or by calling (914) 961-3453 (select Golf Starter off Golf Menu). For weekend and holiday reservations (Saturday, Sunday, and holidays), a reservation request slip **MUST** be completed and deposited in the reservation box outside the Golf Pro Shop by 9am Wednesday prior to that weekend. Tee times for that weekend are posted by 3pm Wednesday.
5. Players must report their presence to the Golf Starter 20 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time or must notify same when they will be late or cannot play. Any player failing to do so suffers loss of reservation and may be subject to suspension of reservation system use.
6. Lake Isle reserves the right to alter the reservation system procedures at any time.
7. Golf Starter maintains discretion in providing tee times based on pace-of-play.

## **H. GOLFING INSTRUCTION**

1. The Golf Pro and Lake Isle teaching staff are the only persons authorized to give golf instruction for a fee.
2. The instructor and the individual, in the course of taking a lesson are the only persons authorized to hit regular golf balls on the driving range or the first hole grass teaching tee. All other persons must use designated golf balls for warming up or for practice.
3. To arrange for a lesson, please call the Golf Pro at (914) 961-3453 (select Golf Pro Shop off Golf Menu).
4. Buckets of practice golf balls are available for rent for a fee in the Golf Pro Shop.

## **I. DAILY FEE USE**

1. Resident daily fee use times begin at 10am on weekdays and 12pm on weekends. Valid ID (i.e., driver's license) is necessary to prove residency.
2. A Non-Resident daily fee user must be accompanied by a member or Resident daily fee user at all times and same time restrictions apply as noted in Paragraph I. 1. above.

## **III. POOL COMPLEX RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **A. GENERAL**

1. All pool users must cooperate fully with the rules and regulations enforcement efforts of the Pool Management, Lifeguards and Staff. Failure to adhere to the directives of same may result in eviction from the pool complex and/or snack areas. All General Rules and Regulations (Section I) apply in addition to Pool Complex Rules and Regulations.
2. An appropriate Lake Isle issued membership card must be displayed and/or receipts for payment presented to gain admission into the pool complex. Failure to have your membership card with you may result in fee payment for admission.

3. Personal belongings, including bags, carts, chairs, or any other items, may not be left unattended at or near the front gate or pool entrance area to hold a place in line prior to pool opening. Items found unattended will be removed by staff.
4. Members who temporarily leave the pool complex and wish to return the same day must present their membership card upon re-entry or request a re-entry stamp from the front gate staff before exiting. Entry without membership card or a re-entry stamp will not be permitted.
5. Pool Management has full authority to clear the pool complex during the threat of electrical storms or other hazardous situations.
6. No one shall use any pool unless Lifeguard(s) are in attendance at the pool. Lifeguard decisions are final in all matters pertaining to safety in use of pools.
7. No glass of any sort is permitted in the pool complex. Any glass will be immediately confiscated without return.
8. Non-swimmers are not permitted to use the Diving Pool. Non-swimmers who cannot stand up in the shallow end of the Olympic Pool must be accompanied by an adult (age 18 and over). Only Coast Guard approved and labeled vests are permitted (except Diving Pool).
9. Only adults (age 18 and over) are permitted access into the Adult Pool area (except for special events authorized by Lake Isle Management).
10. If weather is inclement and pools are closed as of 6pm, then pools will remain closed for the day. When weather is in question, call the Lifeguard Office at (914) 961-3453.

## **B. CHILDREN**

1. Children under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult (age 18 and over) to obtain admission into the pool complex; they must be supervised by same at all times while in the pool complex.
2. Only children under the age of 14 are permitted to have a child care worker.
3. Use of Wading Pool (most shallow pool in depth) is limited to those children age 5 and under; direct supervision is required (as per B.1. above).
4. Use of Training (Mushroom) Pool is limited to those children age 12 and under; direct supervision is required (as per B.1. above).
5. The Kiddie Pools and surrounding areas are designated exclusively for children and their accompanying parent, guardian or immediate relative.
6. Non-toilet trained children must wear a swim diaper under appropriate bathing attire when in pools. These children are limited to the Kiddie Pools only. The use of swim diapers in any other pool is strictly prohibited.
7. A Swim Team member under age 14 must be accompanied by an adult (age 18 and over) who is either a member or a paid guest to enter the pool complex. The Swim Team member must be supervised at all times when in the pool complex.

## **C. POOL CONDUCT**

1. Lounging on steps and ladders leading into pools, diving from pool ladders or decks and other activities disrupting the intended use of same are prohibited.
2. Acrobatics, horseplay, rough-housing and running on pool decks are prohibited.
3. Diving is not permitted into the Olympic Pool, Kiddie Pools and Adult Pool.
4. Regular chairs provided by Lake Isle in various areas are not to be removed from those particular areas. Patrons are not to use these chairs for foot rests. Only one chair per person and saving of same for those not in attendance is prohibited.
5. The below items apply to the use of the Diving Pool:
  - General swimming is not permitted. Users must exit this pool immediately upon completion of dive at the nearest ladder.
  - Water area in front of diving board must be clear before executing a dive.
  - No diving from Diving Pool deck; diving is permitted from diving boards only.

- No diving from sides of diving boards; only one bounce is permitted before executing dive.
  - No sitting on Diving Pool perimeter grates.
  - Only one person at a time is permitted on a diving board.
6. "Lap" lanes are for swimming laps, authorized activities, competitive practices and meets only. Lanes must be entered from the starting blocks side; no one may swim across or enter otherwise. Two designated swimming lanes are marked for adults (age 18 and over) use only. A designated non-swimming lane is provided at the Olympic Pool solely for wading use by adults (age 18 and over). Resting on lane lines is prohibited.
7. Starting blocks are to be used only under the discretion of a certified coach or swim instructor.

#### **D. DRESS CODE, EQUIPMENT AND HYGIENE**

1. Pool Management reserves the right to determine whether any item, toy, piece of equipment, or attire is permitted or prohibited.
2. Bathing suits will be required of all persons using the pools. Cut-off jeans of any type and other clothing not considered acceptable bathing attire are prohibited. All bathing attire must conform to an acceptable standard of decency. Footwear of any kind, except for water shoes is prohibited.
3. Swimming equipment usage:
  - Snorkels and fins are permitted in the lap lanes only and are restricted to adults (age 18 and over)
  - Bathing caps, nose and ear plugs and swim goggles are permitted.
  - Only Coast Guard approved and labeled vests are permitted (vests are prohibited in Diving Pool).
  - Training devices (kick boards, pull paddles, etc.) will be allowed in the lap lanes only.
  - Pool noodles are permitted at the Adult Pool only.
  - Swim masks that cover your nose, inflatables, rafts, body boards or any other flotation devices are prohibited (except as authorized for special activity periods).
4. Toys will be permitted for use in the Kiddie Pools only. Water balls, diving sticks and rings are permitted in the Kiddie and Olympic Pools. Large squirt guns are prohibited.
5. Spitting, spouting of water, blowing nose, urinating or defecating in any pool is prohibited. Individuals with cuts, open sores/wounds and infectious diseases are prohibited from the pools.

#### **E. GROUND RULES**

1. Personal outdoor type chairs and lounges may be brought into the pool complex on a daily basis; they may not be stored on the premises.
2. Chairs, lounges and any other personal property (including strollers and carts, etc.) may not be placed on pool decks within 5 feet of any pool. Pool personnel may prohibit the admission or request the removal of items deemed unsafe or inappropriate for use in the pool complex or on the premises in general.
3. Dressing or undressing of anyone (including infants) in the pool complex, Snack Bar or parking areas is prohibited. Please use restroom facilities.
4. Radios and any other audio/visual devices must be equipped and operated with earphones.
5. Disposable diapers must be wrapped in a plastic bag before being put in receptacles.
6. The below items apply to the use of the playground:
  - Running, pushing, or rough play is prohibited.
  - No eating or drinking within the playground area.
  - Playground equipment is for children ages 12 and under only. Follow all posted signs indicating age restrictions for specific equipment.
  - Avoid climbing on parts of the playground equipment and surrounding fencing that are not designated for climbing. Do not jump off any portion of the playground equipment.
  - Pouring water onto slides or other equipment is prohibited.
  - Be cautious of hot surfaces. Check equipment before use to avoid burns.

## **F. FOOD AND BEVERAGES**

1. Food may only be consumed in pool complex designated eating areas.
2. Beverages (non-alcoholic) are permitted for consumption in the pool areas, but not in the pools.
3. The following shall apply specifically to designated eating area use:
  - All garbage and recyclables must be deposited in the appropriate receptacles. Tables must be completely cleared before departing.
  - Maximum use is one table per family. Smaller groups are requested to share tables.
  - Saving of tables is not permitted.
4. No alcoholic beverages may be brought into or consumed anywhere in the pool complex.
5. No cooking is permitted anywhere in the pool complex.

## **G. SMOKING AND VAPING POLICY**

There is one designated smoking and vaping area (South Lawn by the Diving Pool). Smoking and vaping is prohibited in all other areas. Signs are posted.

## **H. DAILY FEE USE**

1. Resident: Daily fee use begins at 1:30pm. One must be accompanied by a member in order to use the facilities before 1:30pm Valid ID (i.e. driver's license) is necessary to prove residency.
2. Non-Resident: Daily fee use as strictly a walk-in is not available. A Non-Resident daily fee user must be accompanied by a member or Resident daily fee user at all times. Same time restrictions apply as noted in Paragraph H. 1.

## **IV. TENNIS RULES AND REGULATIONS**

### **A. GENERAL**

1. All players must cooperate fully with the rules and regulations enforcement efforts of the Sportime Tennis Management and Staff. All General Rules and Regulations (Section I) apply in addition to Tennis Rules and Regulations.
2. United States Tennis Association (U.S.T.A.) rules govern all tennis play. All players are required to comply with these rules including those pertaining to proper tennis etiquette.
3. Only those players who have made tennis court reservations and those who have signed in on the tennis court sign-up sheet are granted tennis court use for a designated hour.
4. Only those engaged in tennis play and those performing authorized work or tennis related functions are permitted on the tennis courts.
5. No food or alcoholic beverages are permitted on tennis courts.
6. Children under age 14 may not be left unattended. Children of this age must at all times be directly accompanied and supervised by an adult (age 18 and over) while anywhere on the premises.
7. Lake Isle may reserve courts for tournament play, Lake Isle matches, round robins, leagues and for other special events as deemed appropriate by the Sportime Tennis Management and Staff.
8. If weather is inclement, court(s) may be closed. Decisions on closure and reopening of tennis courts by the Sportime Tennis Management and Staff are final. When weather is in question, call Sportime at (914) 777-5151.
9. Hours of night tennis may be subject to change during various times of the season. Notice will be given whenever possible.

### **B. CHILDREN (USE OF TENNIS COURTS)**

1. Children, ages 10 through 17, may reserve and play on any court during the hours of 1pm through 6pm and their use during this period is encouraged.
2. Children, ages 10 through 17, may play any time courts are unoccupied at ten (10) minutes past the hour.

3. Children, under the age of 10, may play during the hours of 1pm through 6pm when accompanied by an adult (age 18 and over).

### **C. DRESS CODE**

Proper tennis attire is required at all times. Shirts must be worn. Playing in bathing or gym-type shorts, cut-off jeans or slacks, or underwear-type shirts is prohibited. Only those wearing tennis sneakers will be permitted on courts.

### **D. TENNIS COURT RESERVATIONS**

1. Tennis Court time reservations are accepted for all seven days from Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day. Such reservations are for hourly play to commence at 7am or later on a daily basis.
2. Reservations for play are to be made by calling Sportime at (914) 777-5151 or in person. Reservations may only be made during the hours of 10:30am through 5pm
3. Members may only obtain one hour of reserved court time daily. Members requesting tennis court reservations must submit the last names of all players to make use of the court reserved. No first names allowed when reserving court time. Any additional play may only take place at ten (10) minutes after the hour on an empty tennis court (no reservation, cancellation, no-show). If more than one party of players wishes to play on the empty court, straws will be drawn to determine who gets the free court based on the following priorities:

First: Players who haven't played that day

Second: Players with one prior hour of play that day

Third: Players with two prior hours of play that day

4. Reservations for play on weekends and holidays (as celebrated by Lake Isle) will be accepted as follows: The prior Tuesday for that Saturday and the prior Wednesday for that Sunday and Monday Holiday (if applicable) during the hours of 10:30am through 5:00pm.
5. Reservations for play on weekdays excluding holidays will be accepted on the preceding day (10:30am - 5pm ONLY).
6. Reservations for the "same day" play may be made in person or by phone anytime for Priority Access Courts and up to 6 hours before for General Access Courts. Reservations are deemed forfeited if the full group is not on the reserved court by ten (10) minutes after the hour. The time is designated by the timepiece used by tennis personnel.
7. Persons unable to play at their reserved court time must notify tennis personnel of cancellation at least two (2) hours prior to their reserved court time. Repeat violation of this rule may result in suspension of reservation privileges.
8. Lake Isle reserves the right to at any time alter reservation procedures including the time of season and hours of day for which reservations will be accepted.
9. In the event of any disputes, the Tennis Pro or a designee thereof will make the final decision.
10. All players must check in at the Sportime Clubhouse front desk before commencing play.

### **E. TENNIS INSTRUCTION**

Only the Sportime Pro Staff is permitted to give tennis instruction for a fee at Lake Isle.

**G. DAILY FEE USE**

1. Daily fee use is permitted on any day that courts are open for play commencing at 1pm through 10pm. Daily fee use is for one hour of play and play is contingent upon court availability.
2. Daily fee use may commence at 12pm (weekdays) when accompanied by a Lake Isle member with tennis privileges.
3. Non-Resident daily fee users must be accompanied by a Lake Isle member at all times.
4. Resident daily fee users must show a valid ID (i.e., driver's license) to prove residency.
